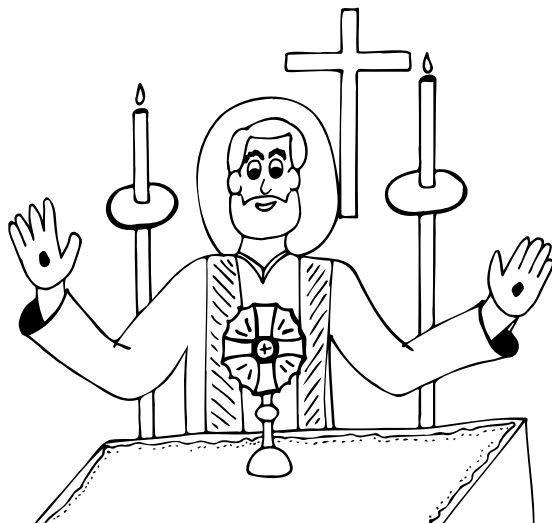


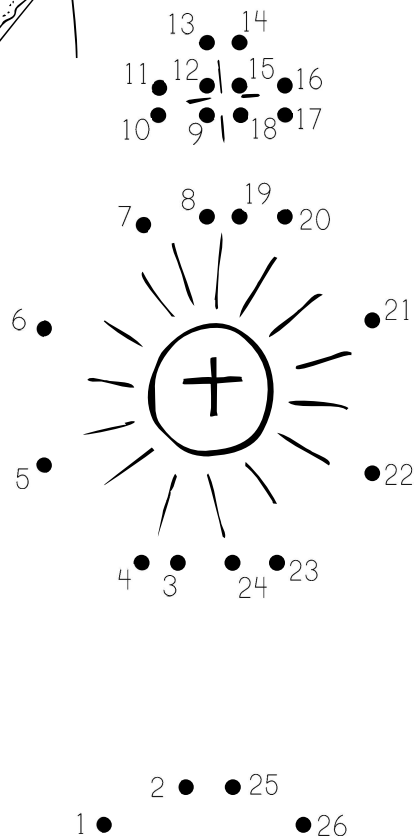
Saint Padre Pio

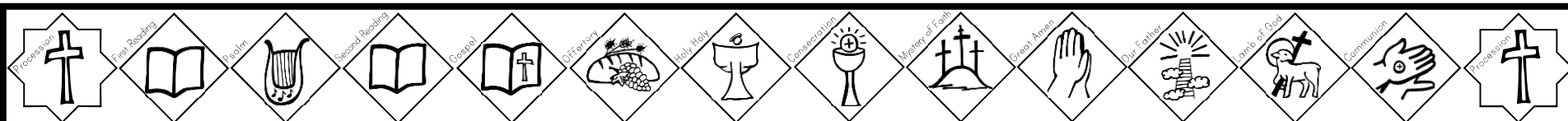

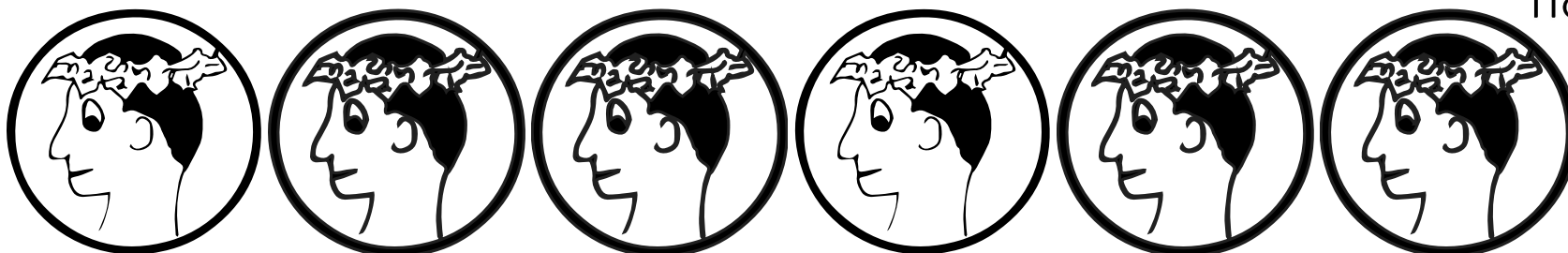

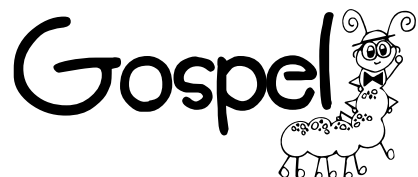


How Many?
